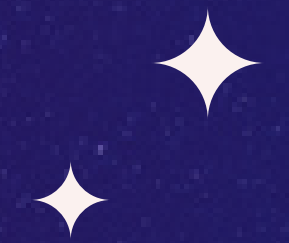


2. Marketing Advertisement

Usage of learnings

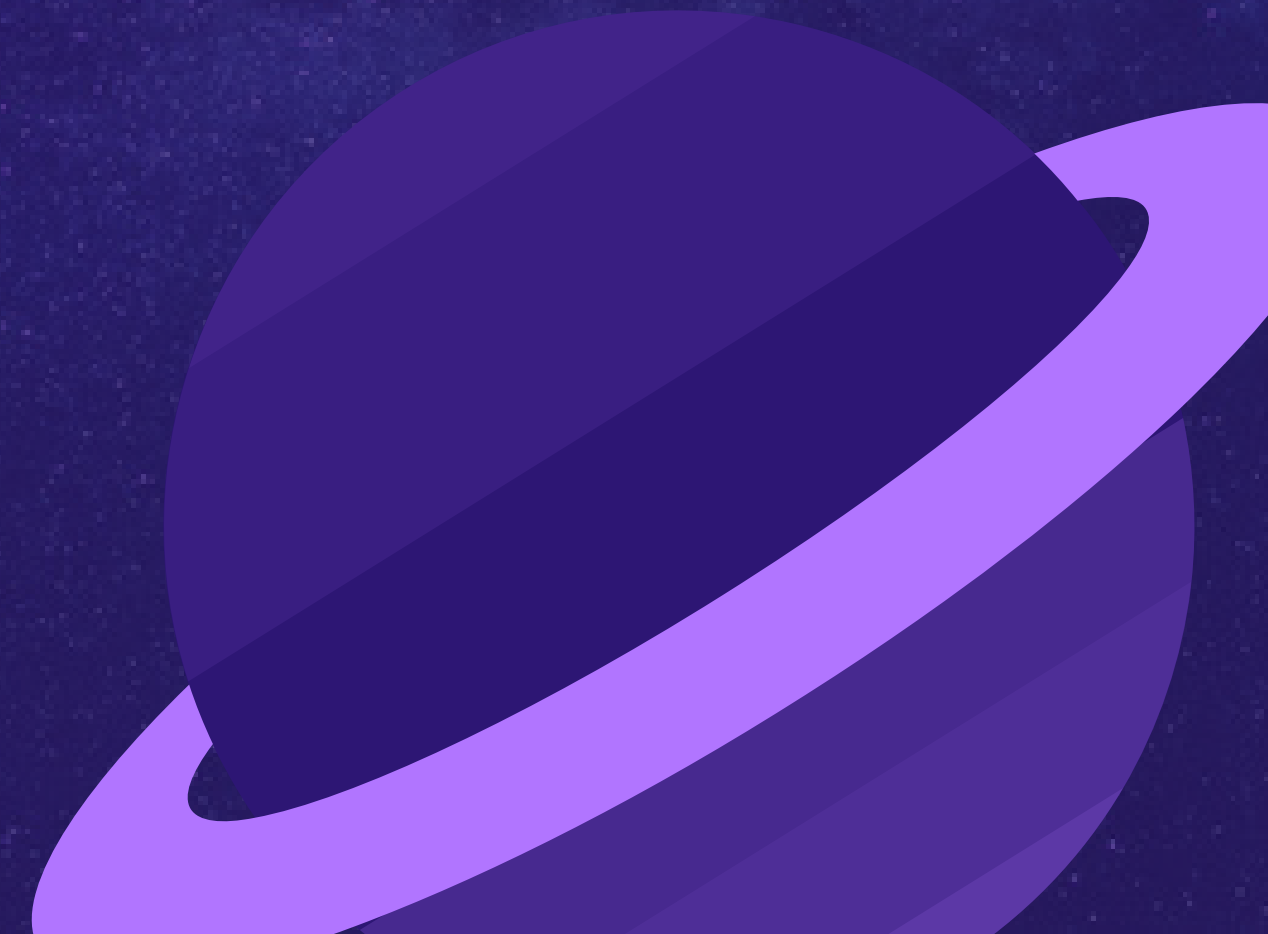
Being able to edit videos could help me in future school projects or even work.
